The aim is to meet people in precarious situations in their living and social space, to address them proactively and to **offer low-threshold support**. The online street workers seek contact with the target group on the "digital streets" of their online lives in the **comment columns under posts on Instagram, Facebook and TikTok**. They also try to reach the target group through **targeted advertising of posts**.

Via the platform [lam-street Berlin](#), streetwork@online published youth-oriented videos as well as text and image materials. The **narrative videos** feature strong personalities whose life stories - experiences, goals, passions but also fears - are meant to inspire young people to go their own way.



In addition to online-streetwork as a core field of work, streetwork@online offers [workshops](#) for multipliers to sensitise them to work with young people in the areas of radicalisation processes and Islamism in the virtual space.
